## **JOWELL, Tessa**

I'm a proud member of Unison and I have always been proud of what the trade unions and Labour Party can achieve together. That means building the homes we need, affordable transport Londoners can rely on, and unleashing London's full potential through opportunity for all. It means a higher minimum wage for London as a first step to making it a Living Wage city. I'm the son of a UNISON member mum who helped me beat the odds and get from Broadwater farm to being an MP. In the coming years London will face unprecedented pressures from Tory austerity making it harder for working Londoners to get opportunities like I had. I've fought tirelessly to prevent the closure of the Whittington Hospital, stood with local cleaners demanding fair pay, marched with public sector workers against the pay freeze and as Minister stood up for our public services and those who rely on them most.

As Mayor I'll ramp up the number of new homes built and make sure keyworkers are never priced out. I'll make night buses free for the night workers who keep our city safe, healthy and clean. I'll bring back Night Schools, because we need learning throughout our careers. And I'll deliver free childcare for every London pre-school child.
